MVR Monitoring provides access to nationwide PSP reports to review violations related to excessive driving hours.

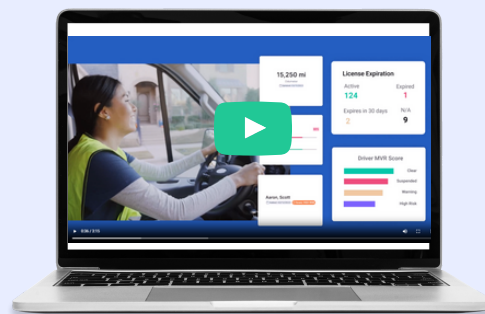
