Hiring Practices

Hiring inexperienced or high-risk drivers increases exposure to accidents.

Poor Safety Record

Repeated violations or past crashes can signal negligence in court.



Lack of Supervision

Failing to actively monitor drivers or track their behavior increase liability risk.

5 Steps to Reduce Risk

- Set Safety Protocols
 Establish and enforce companywide safety standards.
- Implement Driver Training Train driver regularly on safety practices and company policies.
- 3 Document Everything

 Maintain up-to-date driver files and corrective actions that were taken.
- 4 Continuous Driver Monitoring
 Utilize tools to monitor driver
 behavior and identify risks early.
- Cultivate a Safety Culture Promote safety as a core value within the organization.
